Westminster & City Anti-Cuts Campaign Launch Meeting

We are facing a massive attack on both public and private sector jobs; on services; on wages & conditions. Yet unions and their members are fighting back. The FBU, RMT, TSSA, PCS, UNITE, CWU, NUJ, UCU, UNISON, GMB, ASLEF, POA have all been involved in disputes this year – but, in doing so, have had to face up to the anti-union laws.

We have to continue to build the campaign of resistance. In Westminster & City we want to do this from the base up – getting local reps and members involved. We want to build solidarity between unions and develop links with local organisations that represent pensioners, students, parents, tenants and users of services.

We also recognise that the proposed cuts will have a disproportionate effect on different sections of the community – with the young, pensioners, women, those with disabilities and ethnic minorities being hit particularly hard. Despite what the Con-Dem coalition says, we are not “all in this together”.

This meeting is open to anyone who lives and/or works in Westminster and City of London. We want to develop a unified campaign that builds maximum support for the anti-cuts campaign and the union movement’s alternative policies and programme.
